- ◆ Elevation of 5,430 feet
- ◆ Open year-round with 2,040 acres of water and 1,900 acres of public lands
- ◆ 6.5 miles long, 212 feet deep at deepest point
- ◆ Fishing, boating, camping, picnicking, swimming, water-skiing, rock climbing
- ◆ Great fishing: walleye, smallmouth bass, trout and other species
- ◆ 5 waterfront cabins available April October

### Regulations to Help Us Serve You

- Quiet hours are 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- ◆ Alcohol is only allowed in campsites and on boats. No alcohol in day use areas.
- ◆ Pets must be leashed at all times (10 ft. max.) and must not be left unattended.
- ◆ Camping allowed in designated sites only.
- ◆ Life jackets of the appropriate size are required for each person on a boat or paddle-craft and must be worn by children under the age of 13 at all times.

#### **Entrance Permits**

- ◆ Required of all visitors at all times
- ◆ Annual Entrance Permits valid for a year from month of purchase, transferable among vehicles registered to the same household. Buy at entrance stations, nearby retail outlets or online. For a list of where you can purchase each permit, visit www.larimer.org/naturalresources/permits

◆ Daily Entrance Permits - valid day of purchase until noon the next day. Buy at entrance stations and self-serve stations.




